## 2014 APPLICATION FOR APEGBC POST-SECONDARY ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP

APEGBC offers several entry scholarships to British Columbia high school graduates entering engineering or geoscience programs at the University of British Columbia, University of Northern British Columbia, University of Victoria, British Columbia Institute of Technology or Simon Fraser University. The entry scholarships, valued at \$2,500 each, are awarded on the basis of a combination of factors including academic standing, extracurricular activities, financial need and a student statement.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the university upon confirmation of registration (if successful, you should indicate on your university fee card that a scholarship was awarded by APEGBC). *All applicants must be graduating from high school in 2014.*

1. Submit the completed signed application form by **Thursday, June 26, 2014** to APEGBC - Attention: Post-Secondary Entrance Scholarships. *This must be a typed copy. Hand written applications will not be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated.*
2. Arrange for a certified copy of your final transcripts (**including your provincially examinable courses**) to be sent to APEGBC. If we do not receive your transcripts by **Tuesday, August 5, 2014** your application may **not** be considered.
3. Final selection will be completed and successful candidates will be notified in September 2014.

- a member of APEGBC (Professional Engineer or Professional Geoscientist). If this is not possible, a prominent member of your community.
