2014 APPLICATION FOR APEGBC POST-SECONDARY ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP

APEGBC offers several entry scholarships to British Columbia high school graduat es entering engineering or geoscience programs at the University of British Columbia, University of Northern British Columbia, University of Victoria, British Columbia Institute of Technology or Simon Fraser University. The entry scholarships, valued at \$2,500 each, are awarded on the basis of a combination of factors in cluding academic standing, extracurricular activities, financial need and a student statement.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the university upon confirmation of registration (if successful, you should indicate on your university fee card that a scholarship was awarded by APEGBC). All applicants must be graduating from high school in 2014.
